The leadership for Boy Scout Troop #113 is outstanding and was recognized for their years of service during the worship service on Scout Sunday.







Sunday, Feb. 24th, was Committee Awareness Day at Weirsdale Presbyterian Church.


Many committees active in the church put together these wonderful, informative picture boards to increase the congregation's awareness of groups that work to help make our church the blessed place it is for all of us.





