

UPDATE ON THE MANSE RENAISSANCE CAMPAIGN

\$40,000 The Manse Renaissance Capital Campaign is underway! We have targeted a **\$35,000** goal of \$50,000 to be raised to make needed improvements to the Manse.

The amount pledged to date for the Manse Renaissance is \$24,650.

\$30,000 We applied for a \$5,000 grant from the Presbytery and received word that it \$25,000 would be awarded to us!

\$20,000 If all pledges are fulfilled by the end of June, along with other transfers, we will have raised at least \$32,000!

\$15,000 We are still in need of additional funds in order to complete the projects we have\$10,000 planned. So if you haven't made your pledge yet, please consider doing so.


